The Collections have also been produced in digitised format – the catalogues in pdf format and the recordings in 128kbps mp3 sound.

Almost every subject under the sun is touched upon in the recordings.

**Crafts:** Woodwork crafts, building crafts, workshop crafts, textiles and home crafts are detailed.

**History:** Many historians are featured in the Collections, and subjects recorded include the Norman and Cromwellian invasions, the 1798 Rebellion, The Famine, Land Agitation, the Rising of 1916, the War of Independence, the Civil War, The Economic War, The Congested District Board, the Land Commission and the Emergency.

**Customs and Beliefs:** The fascinating beliefs and customs of our ancient past are examined.

**Folklore and Folktales:** The folklore and folktales of other days were told and retold around the firesides of Ireland over centuries past and thus the oral tradition was perpetuated in stories of the supernatural gentry – the fairies, the banshee, the pooka and other restless spirits.

**Ancient Irish Archaeology:** Irish archaeology is an unrivalled treasure. Several leading archaeologists discuss on site the many unique wonders to be seen around the counties of Ireland. Sites visited include Skellig Michael, Beginish Island, Holy Island on Lough Derg, The Burren, Monaincha, Scattery Island, ancient roadways and standing stones, ringforts, cutaway bogs, stone alignments, churches and castles.

**Journeyman:** The Spailpín and the journeymen are recalled, the tinsmiths, 'The Knights of the Road', the displaced people who travelled around the countryside singing their old ballads and playing music to make the world a lighter place in times of hardship and trouble during Ireland's long and turbulent history.

**Education:** Rural schools, hedge schools, the origins and development of technical colleges, libraries, the teaching methods and curricula are explored and discussed.

**Politics:** Ministers, T.Ds and Local Government personnel are recorded.

**Religious Orders:** Life in religion is examined.

**Health:** Tales of old cures, diseases and famine are recalled.

**Inventions:** The arrival of electricity, motor cars, piped water and communications systems are recalled and their impact explained.

**Entertainments:** Traditional music, song and dance are discussed and enjoyed, and story telling and local recitations are recorded with great talent and huge integrity.
